

Catholic School Tuition Reduction Grant

Financial Aid, Gonzaga University



The Gonzaga University Spokane Diocese Tuition Reduction Program provides tuition discounts to full-time teachers, principals and Pastoral/Diocesan Ministers working in schools or parishes under the auspices of the Diocese of Spokane. Individuals who are employed on a part-time basis are not eligible for the tuition reduction program. Gonzaga Prep teachers, principals or pastoral ministers are also eligible for this program.

The reduction will be applicable only to the University's regular and summer session offerings. The discount will not apply to courses or programs that have special tuition rates (i.e., Site-based Education Centers of the School of Education, etc.), or to faculty-led or study abroad courses. All fees, room and board, books, and other non-tuition expenses will be charged to students at the full rate. The combination of institutional grants and scholarships and the Tuition Reduction Grant cannot exceed the cost of tuition for a given term.

Applicants for the Gonzaga Catholic School Tuition Reduction Program must be seeking a degree in one of the following programs with the discounts:

Master of Arts in Philosophy	37% Tuition Grant
Master of Arts in Theology and Leadership	35% Tuition Grant
Master of Arts in Leadership and Administration	50% Tuition Grant
Master of Education in Special Education	50% Tuition Grant
Master of Arts in Communication and Leadership	50% Tuition Grant
Master of Arts in Organizational Leadership	50% Tuition Grant
Master of Business Administration	50% Tuition Grant

Gonzaga University reserves the right to limit the number of Tuition Reduction Program participants in any particular course or program, and it is understood that students will be admitted on a "space available" basis.
