

Teacher: Special Services

Cataldo Catholic School is looking for a teacher leader capable of both teaching students with special needs, including those who struggle and those who are accelerated, and providing the leadership and management skills necessary to administer and build a strong special services program.

Minimum Position Requirements: Knowledge of and commitment to the Cataldo Catholic School philosophy, mission, and “A Cataldo Catholic School Graduate is” statements. These statements are available at www.cataldo.org. Washington State Certified teacher endorsed to teach K-8 students or in the process of earning (or willing to earn) such endorsement. Ability to personalize learning by developing and implementing individualized learning plans in addition to leading a team of support teachers, teaching assistants, and volunteers. Strong communications with peers, parents, other schools, districts, and agencies. Strong classroom management, and discipline skills. Leadership and management skills. Non-Catholic applicants who can support the teachings of the Catholic Church regarding faith and morals in both word and action are welcome to apply.

Credentials Preferred but Not Required: Practicing Catholic knowledgeable of the Catholic faith and traditions. Successful experience teaching students with special needs including highly capable students. Specific endorsement in special education. An applicant with a principal endorsement may also receive preference.

Timeline: This position is open until filled. The position is full-time and begins August 21st.
