Directions to Barrister Winery

Located about midway between Jefferson and Adams Streets on Railroad Avenue which runs adjacent to the south side of the railroad overpass – not to be confused with Railroad Alley which is on the north side of the railroad overpass. If lost call: 465-3591

From I-90, take the Lincoln Street exit; on Lincoln, turn left (west) onto Second Avenue; go three blocks then turn right (north) onto Jefferson Street; then turn left (west) immediately before the railroad overpass onto Railroad Avenue.

PARKING: There is limited parking in front of the winery. Metered street parking is available on Adams and Jefferson. FREE PARKING after 5pm at Bernardo Architecture, 153 S. Jefferson, and at Meals on Wheels on 2nd Ave. The winery is handicap accessible.
